# **Chief's Report**

Chief reported that there were 33 activities for the month of March bringing the total for the year to 93; 55 of which were fire calls. There were lots of storm related calls last month. Received an application for a new junior member and one for a new adult member. Membership is still a struggle and a priority. Motion to accept the Chief's report was made by Commissioner Schmidt, seconded by Commissioner Cook and carried.

Fire Official's Report

Fire Official Serrecchia reported that there was a total of 15 home inspections for the month of March, and 4 plan reviews. Fire watch invoice was sent to 112 Main Road. There is a new state law regarding the installation of carbon monoxide detectors in all businesses that have fuel burning appliances. Also, fire extinguishers now have to be certified. Fire Official Serrecchia met with the fire officials in Towaco and Pinebrook regarding the ordinance for permit fees. State fees have gone up. In order to save future lawyer bills the ordinance was sent to Counselor Bucco to rewrite so it will be tied to the state fees and will not have to be amended at town level should those fees change. Motion to accept the Fire Officials report was made by Commissioner Purnell; seconded by Commissioner Caggiano, and carried.
