Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of March 14 were read and accepted as read. The minutes of the special meeting of February 16 were read and accepted as read. Motion to accept March minutes made by Commissioner Purnell, seconded by Commissioner Cook and carried. The minutes of the special meeting of February 16 were read and accepted as read. Motion to accept February minutes made by Commissioner Cook, seconded by Commissioner Schmidt and carried.

Financial Report

The Treasurer gave the financial report and presented the bills for payment; the vouchers were reviewed by the commissioners and paid as follows on a motion made by Commissioner Purnell, seconded by Commissioner Cook, and carried:

Commissioner Caggiano reported that the Boiling Springs account has been changed to two twelve month CDs and interest on the accounts increased to 2%. The tax levy check has been received. Lakeland Bank said that the commissioner's account is considered a business account and therefore they are unable to raise interest rates. Motion to accept the

financial report was made by Commissioner Cook; seconded by Commissioner Purnell, and carried.

Chief's Report

The Chief reported that there had been a total of 16 activities for the month of March, 10 of which were fire calls bringing the total for the year to 58; 40 of which were fire calls. Chief reported that driver training is ongoing. There will also be training in advanced extrication and airbags. Recruitment efforts have been attracting new members. Department has been using Facebook posts for National Volunteer week as well as other forms of social media. The Chief reported that there will be controlled burns at Pyramid Mountain. The men are still experiencing communication problems at the north end of town. Chief is looking into purchasing battery operated hydraulic tools, known as Edraulics. Motion to accept the Chief's report was made by Commissioner Purnell, seconded by Commissioner Schmidt, and carried.

Fire Official's Report

Fire Official Serrecchia reported that there was a total of 6 home inspections for the month of March. Fire Official reported that he has still has not heard anything from the town regarding the fireworks request by a town resident. Fire Official has requested any and all correspondence on 155 River Road from the state. Inspections have been done at all the schools; there are still outstanding violations that need to be addressed. Dryer vent cleaning remains an issue at Chase and Campagna. Motion to accept the Fire Officials report was made by Commissioner Purnell; seconded by Commissioner Schmidt, and carried.

Old Business

Roof repairs are complete at station one and three. The gutter on the original roof at station one is in need of repair. Pine Brook reports that they are still having radio problems at Montgomery. Towaco reports no problem. Chief states that communications are still not as clear as they could be at Turkey Hill. John Connelly will be contacting Northeast Communications. Shingles for the roof at station two are being donated, and possibly delivered. Dun Rite agreed to do the roof for the cost of the labor using the donated shingles.

New Business

Commissioners discussed a quote received for Workman's Comp insurance from AmTrust that is a considerable savings over the current policy. Motion made by Commissioner Cook, seconded by Commissioner Schmidt to accept quote and move

policy to AmTrust. All in favor. On a motion made by Commissioner Cook and seconded by Commissioner Purnell the commissioners approved the application of Joseph Nanartowicz as a member of Company One. All in favor. Commissioners discussed the condition of the parking lot at station one which is need of repairs or replacement. Commissioner Cook will be speaking to the Township Committee about passing an ordinance to allow District One to use county paving resources. Men are checking into the pricing for the mural on the new rescue truck. Purchases of eight new air bottles, and thirteen air pack upgrades have been made. Men are looking at purchasing battery operated Edraulics.

Adjournment

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Purnell and seconded by Commissioner Schmidt, and carried. Meeting was adjourned by Chairman Lewis at 9:25 PM.
