The department participated in a drill on Conklin Farm setting up a landing zone. Station one needs a new router and booster. Tagged hose blew during testing. Will need to purchase a new hose. Rosenbauer is working on the ladder portion of the new ladder truck. Hose dryer quotes – least expensive is \$11,000.00. Would need an electrician to install it. Clothing allowance tabled till next meeting. Motion to accept Chief's report was made by Commissioner Schmidt; seconded by Commissioner Cook and carried.

Fire Official's Report

In the absence of the Fire Official the district clerk gave the report. Reported that there was a total of 32 home inspections for the month of July. Fire Prevention is interested in updating the Enforsys reporting program currently in use by the Fire Prevention Bureau and the department. Motion to accept Fire Official's report was made by Commissioner Caggiano; seconded by Commissioner Schmidt and carried.
