Workman's Comp policy is being paid this month as well as the bill for the new jaws. In the absence of the chief the report was read by the clerk. For the month May total fire calls were fourteen; total activities for the month fourteen. Total year to date activities is 84. Motion to accept Chief's report was made by Commissioner Schmidt; seconded by Commissioner Purnell and carried.

Fire Official's Report

Fire Official gave his report. There was a total of 8 home inspections for the month of June. Inspections were done by the sellers in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State of New Jersey. Fire Prevention has completed the inspections of the schools and there are outstanding violations for all of them. Fourth of July fireworks has been cancelled. The town is allowing outdoor seating at the Columbia Inn and Harrigan's pending the approval of various agencies including the Fire Department and the Fire Prevention Bureau.
