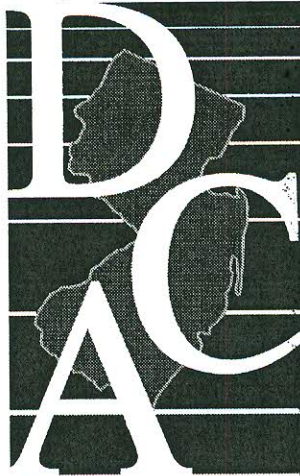





WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.); and





The Fire District proposes an annual budget of \$617,170 for 2020 compared to \$605,837 for 2019. The significant changes are in the normal increases in purchase prices.

Revenues:

The District's Amount to be Raised by Taxation will increase from \$538,817 in 2019 to \$554,270 in 2020 and no Unrestricted Fund Balance will be used, the same as in 2019.

5. Does the Fire District plan on exceeding the Levy Cap? If so, please provide a statement with the reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the Fire District to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

The District is at the 2% maximum cap levy restriction by utilizing \$2,879 from the 2016 Levy Cap Bank.

6. If the Fire District plans to pass a Resolution for the Release of Restricted Fund Balance to be used in the 2020 proposed operating budget, explain the reason and purposes of the appropriation.

This is not applicable in 2020.

The District is budgeting \$116,207 for Future Capital Outlays, an increase from \$100,000 budgeted in 2019.


