The Fire District proposes an Annual Budget of \$570,770.00 for 2015 compared to 608,050.00 for 2014. The significant changes are in the Fringe Benefits and Cost of Providing Services portions of the Budget due to the reallocation of Workmens Comp. and Life Insurance from Fringe Benefits to Insurance.

Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. The District's Amount to be Raised by Taxation will decrease from \$565,400 in 2014 to \$523,800 in 2015 and no Unrestricted Fund Balance will be used the same as in 2014. The reduction in the amount to be raised by taxation is due to the planned retirement of the long time District Clerk.

3. Include a statement explaining how the Fire District is complying with the Property Tax Levy Cap. The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the Fire District to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

The District is below the 2% maximum cap levy restriction and will lapse its unused cap bank of \$23,633 from 2012.


